- A current copy of the student's university transcript must be submitted with the Scholarship Application for verification of enrollment and GPA. Applicant must consent to verification of this information with the University Department Chair.
- Applicant must submit a letter of recommendation with the Scholarship Application. Recommendations may be from a personal, academic or employment reference.
- Applicant may be asked to participate in a personal interview with the selection committee and must be available in person or by phone during the application submission period.

#### APPLICATION PROCESS

LAP Student Membership Applications may be submitted with the Scholarship Application and are also available from the University Department Chairs or our website at Scholarship Application.

Applications must be submitted in typewritten form and must be signed by the applicant.
